Stakeholder Engagement

The NMC launched the new *Future Nurse: Standards of Proficiency for Registered Nurses (2018)* on 17th May 2018 at the Houses of Parliament. The launch also included the Standards of Education and Training and the *Standards of Student Supervision and Assessment (Part 2)* which covers practice learning and assessment and the roles of Practice Supervisor, Practice Assessor and Academic Assessor. The PLPLG are working with our practice stakeholders across London to develop and agree a unified approach to the implementation on these roles. An initial workshop was held on the 17th May to explore the roles and the Steering Group are doing additional work to develop this further.

The Steering Group were joined by 40 education leads from trusts across London representing all fields of practice.

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Field Work

Members of the PLPLG are currently consulting with field specific groups in Adult, Child, Mental Health, Learning Disability and Community and Social Care to support document development and ensure students are appropriately prepared for registration. One Practice Assessment Document per part/year has been agreed, but the document will incorporate some of the additional field specific proficiencies that the field specific groups propose.

Development of Electronic-Practice Assessment Document

A meeting with the London Deans for Health was held on Tuesday 5th June to explore the potential for developing an electronic practice assessment document across London. All 12 universities who have pre-registration courses in London were represented at the meeting. There was unanimous support from all HEI London Deans to develop an e-document and to establish a Consortia for procurement to ensure London has one supplier.
