The total number engaged with to date now exceeds 4,000, which is very positive.

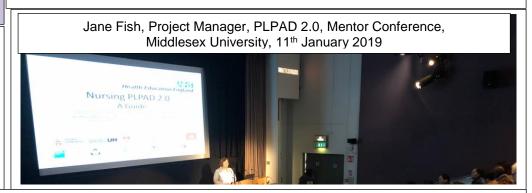
Next steps

The PLPAD Project is now at the next stage where the London universities are preparing for validation of their newly developed curricula – theory and practice. The PLPAD 2.0 will be presented at validation as an integral part of the universities curricula. 7 x London universities plan to validate in 2019 and 5 x London universities will validate in 2020.

Timeline for validation of PLPAD 2.0

Middlesex University – 5th March 2019 King's College London University – 19th March 2019 City, University of London – 20th March 2019 University of Hertfordshire – 20th March 2019 University of West London – May 2019 (tbc) London South Bank University – May 2019 (tbc) Canterbury Christ Church University (tbc)

Other London universities – validating for a September 2020 start date (tbc).



























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Standards for student supervision and assessment

Since the Stakeholder Event in July and October the PLPLG have continued to work on the Pan London approach to the implementation of the SSSA for nursing and midwifery programmes

. We are pleased to inform our practice stakeholders that all universities plan to transition to the SSSA from September 2019. This unified approach and all HEIs transitioning at the same time, should make it easier for our practice partners to implement the new approach to supporting and assessing students in practice.

Tools to support implementation of SSSA

The PLPLG have developed two power point presentations:

- A Pan London Learning Approach to the NMC (2018) Part 2; Standards for Student Supervision and Support
- Nursing PLPAD 2.0 A Guide

These presentations are currently being piloted in practice areas for feedback and will be disseminated to practice areas soon to be used at Mentor updates in Trusts as part of preparation for practice staff undertaking the new roles as outlined in the SSSA.

The PLPLG will be working with practice partners to develop further tools to facilitate a unified approach to support the implementation of the SSSA.

The Power Point slide presentations will be disseminated to Trust partners by the end of January for partners to use as part of preparing staff for the roles of Practice Supervisor and Practice Assessor.
