New NMC standards for pre-registration nursing education

The NMC are developing new education standards for the future nurse. The new standards will be outcome focused and fit for the future, embracing the values set out in the NMC code. The new standards will apply across all fields of practice and all healthcare settings, from acute to community. They will give all nurses, regardless of field, an understanding of mental health and physical care. They will also reflect the growing focus on public health and health education.

- June 2017—NMC draft standards sent out by NMC for consultation
- Spring 2018—Final standards published
- September 2018—some Higher Education Institutions will be early adopters of new standards
- September 2019—ALL Higher Education Institutions to implement new standards.

Pan London Practice Assessment Document

Nine Universities across London successfully validated a Pan London Practice Assessment Document (PLPAD) in 2013 which has been implemented in London since 2014. It was developed with extensive collaboration and consultation with our practice partners, academic staff, students and service users. With the introduction of the new NMC education standards for pre-registration nursing education, the Pan London Practice Learning Group sought funding from Health Education England London Local Offices to develop a new document.

The evaluation of the implementation of the PLPAD, undertaken in 2015 confirmed the benefits of a unified document for London where many practice areas are shared by several universities.

The Pan London Practice Learning Group (PLPLG) want to build on the work we have done and to continue to work with our stakeholders to develop the new document and we are delighted that this work will again be led by Jane Fish as Project Manager.

We would look forward to working with you over the next year.
